Notice of Resumption of Proceedings of Antidumping Investigation in Pursuance to the Decision of the Appellate Tribunal in Appeal Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of 2012 Regarding Imposition of Antidumping Duty on Imports of Tiles into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from the People's Republic of China

National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") made a final determination on May 08, 2012 on dumped imports of Tiles, which includes ceramic, porcelain, vitrified, granite wall and floor tiles in glazed/unglazed, polished/unpolished finish, originating in and/or exported from the People's Republic of China ("China") under Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance 2000 (the "Ordinance") and Anti-Dumping Duties Rules 2001 (the "Rules"). Final determination of the Commission in this case was challenged in the Anti-Dumping Appellate Tribunal through appeal nos. 6 to 10 of 2012. In its decision dated October 1, 2012 the Anti-Dumping Appellate Tribunal has set aside final determination and the case is remitted to the Commission to proceed afresh from the stage of order dated June 24, 2011 to complete proceedings of antidumping investigation following all provisions of the Ordinance. Therefore, in pursuance to the decision of the Appellate Tribunal the Commission has resumed proceedings in this case and all interested parties are intimated through this notice of the proceedings. Procedure to be followed for this proceedings of investigation is set out below:

Product under investigation is Tiles, which includes ceramic, porcelain, vitrified, granite wall and floor tiles in glazed/unglazed, polished/unpolished finish, exported by the exporters from China were the product under investigation (the "investigated product"). It is classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff (PCT) Nos. 6907.1000, 6907.9000, 6908.1000, 6908.9010 and 6908.9090.
