Notice of Impending Expiry of Anti-dumping Duty Levied on Imports of Tinplate into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from the Republic of South Africa

National Tariff Commission (the "Commission"), after making an affirmative final determination in terms of Section 39 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2000 (the "Ordinance"), imposed a definitive anti-dumping duty @ 27.33 percent of C&F price in accordance with Section 50 of the Ordinance, on dumped imports of electrolytic tinplate of a thickness of less than 0.5 mm and of a width of 600 mm or more ("Tinplate") for a period of five years with effect from July 22, 2002 produced by Iscor Ltd., Roger Dyason Road, Pretoria-West, Pretoria 0001, South Africa and exported by MacSteel International SA (Pvt) Ltd., 187 Rivonia Road, Sanston, Johannesburg, South Africa. The five years period expires on July 21, 2007.

- 2. Tinplate is importable under PCT heading No. 7210.1210.
- 3. All interested parties are hereby notified that the definitive antidumping duty levied on dumped imports of Tinplate produced by Iscor Ltd. and exported by MacSteel International, South Africa shall terminate, on expiry of five years from the date of imposition of anti-dumping duty, unless a review under Section 58 (3) of the Ordinance is initiated before the date of termination of the duty. Domestic industry producing Tinplate may file a sunset review application with the Commission on the prescribed form within forty-five days of the publication of this notice, if it so wishes. The sunset review application form is available on the Commission's website www.ntc.gov.pk.
