Notice of Initiation of Sunset Review of Anti-dumping Duties Levied on Dumped Imports of BOPP Film Originating in and/or Exported from the People's Republic of China, Sultanate of Oman, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia <u>and United Arab Emirates</u>

The National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") received an application under Section 58(3) of the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2015 (the "Ordinance") on June 24, 2015 from M/s Tri-Pack Films Limited, Karachi (the "Applicant"), for review of antidumping duties levied on dumped imports of BOPP into Pakistan originating in and/or exporting from People's Republic of China, Sultanate of Oman, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and United Arab Emirates (the "Exporting Countries"). The Applicant is a domestic producer of Biaxially Oriented Polypropylene ("BOPP") Film. This application was made following the notice of impending expiry of definitive anti-dumping duties published in national press and official Gazette on May 12, 2015.

Product under Review

The product under review is BOPP Film originating in and/or exported from the Exporting Countries of a thickness of 8 microns or above, excluding capacitor grade BOPP Film. It is classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff classification number. 3920.2010 (BOPP plain), and 3920.2030 (BOPP metalized).

Anti-dumping Duties in force

The Commission imposed definitive antidumping duties ranging from 22.95 to 57.09 percent *ad val* on dumped imports of BOPP Film from the Exporting Countries w.e.f. August 15, 2012 for a period of three years

Initiation of Review

The Applicant has alleged that expiry of anti-dumping duties would likely to lead continuation or recurrence of dumping of BOPP Film from the Exporting Countries and injury to the domestic industry producing BOPP Film. On examination of the information and evidence provided in application, the Commission has, *prima facie*, determined that there is sufficient evidence to justify initiation of a review under Section 58(3) of the Ordinance. Thus, the Commission hereby initiates a review pursuant to Section 58(3) of the Ordinance to determine whether the expiry of the anti-dumping duties imposed on dumped imports of BOPP Film from the Exporting Countries would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping and injury or not.

Continuation of Anti-dumping Duties

In terms of Section 58(3) of the Ordinance, the anti-dumping duties imposed on dumped imports of BOPP Film from the Exporting Countries will remain in-force pending the outcome of the review.

Period for the Review

The sunset review would be conducted on the basis of information for the last three years i.e. from April 1, 2012 to March 31, 2015.
