Notice of Conclusion of Sunset Review of Anti-dumping Duties Imposed on Dumped Imports of Polyester Staple Fibre Originating in and/or Exported from Indonesia, Korea and Thailand

The National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") under Section 58 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2000 (the "Ordinance") conducted a review ("Sunset Review") of anti-dumping duties imposed with effect from February 09, 2007 against dumped imports of Polyester Staple Fibre, not exceeding 2 denier ("PSF") originating in and/or exported from Indonesia, Korea and Thailand (collectively referred to as the "Exporting Countries"). The Sunset Review was initiated on January 31, 2012 upon receipt of an application under Section 58(3) of the Ordinance from Messrs. ICI Pakistan Limited, Lahore and Ibrahim Fibres Limited, Faisalabad (the "Applicants"), the domestic producers of PSF. The Commission had imposed anti-dumping duties with effect from February 09, 2007 for a period of five years on PSF imported from the Exporting Countries.

In accordance with the Ordinance and the Anti-Dumping Duties Rules, 2001 (the "Rules"), the Commission has conducted and concluded the Sunset Review as follows:

Product Under Review:

The product under review is PSF, not exceeding 2 denier, exported by the exporters and foreign producers from the Exporting Countries. It is classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff ("PCT") No. 5503.2010.

Period of Review (POR):

POR for this Sunset Review was as follows:

For Dumping:From October 01, 2010 to September 30, 2011For Injury:From October 01, 2008 to September 30, 2011

Likelihood of Recurrence of Dumping from Exporting Countries: The Commission has determined that there is likelihood of continuation and/or recurrence of dumping of the product under review from the Exporting Countries if anti-dumping duties imposed on dumped imports of the product under review are terminated.

Likely Continuation and Recurrence of Injury to the Domestic Industry: Likelihood of continuation and recurrence of injury to the domestic industry has been determined by the Commission in accordance with Section 58 (3) of the Ordinance. In this regard, factors and indices listed in Sections 15 and 17 of the Ordinance for injury analysis have been analyzed to determine the likelihood of continuation and/or recurrence of injury in case anti-dumping duties on PSF are terminated. Accordingly, the Commission has determined that, should the anti-dumping duties be terminated, the domestic industry would be likely to suffer material injury.

Continuation of Definitive Anti-Dumping Duties:

In view of the analysis and conclusions with regard to likely continuation and recurrence of dumping of PSF from the Exporting Countries and likely material injury to the domestic industry, there is a need to continue imposition of definitive anti-dumping duties on dumped imports of the product under review. Thus, the Commission has decided to impose definitive anti-dumping duties as per the following table for another period of two years with effect from January 30, 2013:

Anti-dumping duties shall be deposited in the Commission's Non-lapsable PLD Account No. 187 with Federal Treasury Office Islamabad. Anti-dumping duties would be collected in the same manner as customs duty under the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969).

Disclosure meeting: Pursuant to Rule 16 of the Rules, the exporters/foreign producers of the product under review may request for a disclosure meeting within 15 days of the date of publication of this notice.
