Notice of Termination of Anti-dumping Investigation against Alleged Dumping of Caustic Soda from the State of Kuwait, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Taiwan into Pakistan

The National Tariff Commission (the “Commission”) initiated an anti-dumping investigation against alleged dumping of Caustic Soda originating in and/or exported from the State of Kuwait, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and Taiwan into Pakistan on September 29, 2010 under Section 23 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2000 (the “Ordinance”). The investigation was initiated by the Commission after establishing that the application lodged by Sitara Chemical Industries Ltd. and Ittehad Chemicals Ltd. (the “Applicants”), domestic producers of Caustic Soda, was in accordance with Sections 20 and 24 of the Ordinance.

Withdrawal of an Application: The Applicants have withdrawn the anti-dumping application filed with the Commission.

Termination of Investigation: In view of withdrawal of the application by the Applicants and in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 40 of the Ordinance, the Commission has decided to terminate this anti-dumping investigation.
