Notice of Impending Expiry of Definitive Anti-Dumping Duty Levied on Dumped Imports of Secondary Quality Tinplate into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from Belgium, France, Germany, Netherlands and USA.

National Tariff Commission (the "Commission"), after making an affirmative final determination in terms of Section 39 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2000 (the "Ordinance"), imposed a definitive anti-dumping duty at the rate ranging from 11.78% to 39.99% percent of C&F price in accordance with Section 50 of the Ordinance, on dumped imports of secondary quality tinplate, importable under PCT heading Nos. 7210.1210, produced and exported from Kingdom of Belgium ("Belgium"), French Republic ("France"), Federal Republic of Germany ("Germany"), Kingdom of the Netherlands ("Netherlands") and the United States of America ("USA"), for a period of five years with effect from July 16, 2009. The five years period shall expire on July 16, 2014.

All interested parties are hereby notified that the definitive anti-dumping duty levied on dumped imports of secondary quality tinplate, produced and exported from Belgium, France, Germany, Netherlands and USA shall terminate on expiry of five years from the date of imposition of anti-dumping duty, unless a review under Section 58 (3) of the Ordinance is initiated before the date of termination of the duty. Domestic industry producing secondary quality tinplate may file a sunset review application with the Commission on the prescribed form within forty-five days of the publication of this notice, if it so wishes.
