Notice of Impending Expiry of Anti-dumping Duty Levied on Imports of Bixially Oriented Poly Propylene (BOPP) Film into Pakistan Originating in and/or Exported from the People’s Republic of China, Sultanate of Oman, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and United Arab Emirates

National Tariff Commission (the “Commission”) after making an affirmative final determination under Section 39 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Ordinance, 2015 (the Ordinance) on April 9, 2015 ratified the earlier findings of the Commission dated February 04, 2013 regarding standing of the domestic industry, dumping margin, injury to the domestic industry, causal link and imposition of definitive antidumping duties on imports of BOPP Film into Pakistan originated in and/or exported from the People’s Republic of China, Sultanate of Oman, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and United Arab Emirates (the “Exporting Countries”).

The Commission imposed the anti-dumping duties ranging from 22.95% to 57.09% against the imports of BOPP Film, PCT Nos. 3920.2010 and 3920.2030 from the Exporting Countries w.e.f. April 9, 2015 till August 14, 2015.

In terms of Section 58(2) of the Ordinance, it is hereby notified that the definitive antidumping duties levied on dumped imports of BOPP Film, produced and exported by the Exporting Countries shall terminate on August 14, 2015 unless a review under Section 58(3) of the Ordinance is initiated before the date of termination of the duty. Domestic industry producing BOPP Film may file a sunset review application with the Commission on the prescribed form within forty-five days of the publication of this notice, if it so wishes. The sunset review application form may be obtained from the Commission or alternatively, it can be downloaded from the Commission’s website www.ntc.gov.pk.
