

Notice of Initiation of Antidumping Investigation against Alleged Dumped Imports of Phthalic Anhydride into Pakistan Originating in and / or Exported from the Russian Federation

The National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") has received an application under Sections 20 and 24 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the "Act") on October 05, 2016 from M/s Nimir Chemicals Pakistan Limited, Lahore (the "Applicant"). The Applicant has alleged that Phthalic Anhydride ("PA") are being exported to Pakistan at dumped prices from the Russian Federation ("Russia") which has caused and is causing material injury to Pakistan's domestic industry producing PA.

Product Under Investigation: The product allegedly being dumped into Pakistan is Phthalic Anhydride imported from Russia, classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff ("PCT") Heading No. 2917.3500 (the "investigated product"). Basic raw material used for the production of the investigated product is Ortho-xylene. Phthalic Anhydride is an industrial input used in Plasticizers, Alkyed Resins, Polyester Resins, Dyes and Pigments, etc.

Period of Investigation (POI): For determination of dumping and injury, the POI is as follows:

For determination of dumping	From July 01, 2015 to June 30, 2016
For determination of Injury	From July 01, 2013 to June 30, 2016

Investigation Schedule

Initiation date:	Date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan.
Preliminary determination:	Not earlier than 60 days and not later than 180 days from the date of initiation.
Final determination:	Within 180 days of the date of publication of notice of preliminary determination in the press.

Interested Parties: Interested parties, as defined in Section 2(j) of the Act, are requested to identify themselves not later than 15 days after publication of this notice. An interested party applying for registration with the Commission should submit; the name of the company, its line of business, name of authorized person, address, telephone number and fax number. All interested parties are invited to make their views/comments and to submit information and documents (if any) to the Commission not later than 45 days of the date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan.

Public File: A public file has been established and maintained at the office of the Commission in this investigation, which shall be available to interested parties for review and copying from Monday to Thursday between 1100 hours to 1300 hours (except public holidays) throughout the investigation.
