

Notice of Initiation of Anti-Dumping Investigation against Alleged Dumped Imports of Aluminium Beverage Cans into Pakistan Originating in and/ or Exported from Jordan, Sri Lanka ,Turkey and UAE

The National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") has received an application under Sections 20 and 24 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the "Act") on September 04, 2018 from M/s Pakistan Aluminium Beverage Cans Limited (the "Applicant"). The Applicant has alleged that Aluminium Beverage Cans are being exported to Pakistan at dumped prices from Jordan, Sri Lanka ,Turkey and UAE (the "Exporting Countries") which has caused and is causing material retardation of the establishment of Pakistan's domestic industry producing Aluminium Beverage Cans.

Product Under Investigation: The product allegedly being dumped into Pakistan is Aluminium Beverage Cans up to capacity of 300 ml imported from Jordan, Sri Lanka, Turkey and UAE classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff ("PCT") Heading Nos. 7612.9010 and 7612.9030. (the "investigated product"). Basic raw material used for the production of the investigated product is Aluminium Coil. Aluminium Beverage Can is an industrial input which is used for packaging of beverage.

Period of Investigation (POI): For determination of dumping and injury, the POI is as follows:

For determination of dumping	From September 01, 2017 to June 30, 2018
For determination of Injury	From September 01, 2017 to June 30, 2018

Investigation Schedule

Initiation date:	Date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan.
Preliminary determination:	Not earlier than 60 days and not later than 180 days from the date of initiation.
Final determination:	Within 180 days of the date of publication of notice of preliminary determination in the press.

Interested Parties: Interested parties, as defined in Section 2(j) of the Act, are requested to identify themselves not later than 15 days after publication of this notice. An interested party applying for registration with the Commission should submit; the name of the company, its line of business, name of authorized person, address, telephone number and fax number. All interested parties are invited to make their views/comments and to submit information and documents (if any) to the Commission not later than 45 days of the date of publication of this notice in the press in Pakistan.

Public File: A public file has been established and maintained at the office of the Commission in this investigation, which shall be available to interested parties for review and copying from Monday to Thursday between 1100 hours to 1300 hours (except public holidays) throughout the investigation.
