Subject: - Request to Impose Regulatory Duty (RD) on Import of Crank Shaft for Motorcycles (H.S. Code 7326.1910)

Jin Kwang Jaz (Pvt) Ltd, Karachi (the Applicant), a manufacturer of Crank Shaft Forgings for motorcycles engines, has approached the National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") to remove anomaly between finished goods and raw materials. As per the Applicant Customs and Regulatory duties on import of input i.e. Bars and Rods of alloy (PCT. No. 7228.3090) are 35% whereas, Customs duty on output i.e. Crank Shaft (PCT. No. 7326.1910) is 5% under Pakistan China FTA, whereas no regulatory duty is imposed on Crank Shaft. Accordingly, the Applicant has requested to impose Regulatory Duty @ 30% on import of Crank Shaft for Motorcycles (PCT No. 7326.1910).

2. The Commission has initiated an inquiry and would welcome views, suggestions and proposals from all parties having an interest in the business relating to or associated with the imports, manufacturing and marketing of Crank Shaft for Motorcycles. Views/ suggestions may be sent within fifteen days of publication of this public notice, to the Secretary, National Tariff Commission, 4th Floor, State Life Building No. 5, Blue Area, Islamabad.
3. A public hearing on the issue is scheduled to be held on January 14, 2020 at 11.00 a.m. in the Committee Room of National Tariff Commission, 11th Floor, State Life Building No. 5, Blue Area, Islamabad.
4. Further, all parties having an interest in the business relating to or associated with the imports, manufacturing and marketing of Crank Shaft for Motorcycles are hereby advised to get themselves registered with the Commission latest by January 13, 2020 for participation in the public hearing by providing names of the participants with their telephone numbers (Cell/LL) and fax numbers to the Director General (Inv-II) on fax No. 051-9221205. For any further inquiry please contact 051-9202508. All interested parties may submit their comments and suggestions in writing. The comments and suggestions may be supported with essential facts, information and documentary evidence(s), which must be brought to the public hearing. The views not supported with reliable documentary evidence(s) shall not be considered.
