Notice of Initiation of Sunset Review of Anti-Dumping Duties Imposed on Dumped Imports of Aluminium Beverage Cans into Pakistan Originating in and/ or Exported from Jordan, Sri Lanka and United Arab Emirates

National Tariff Commission (the "Commission") received an application on December 27, 2024, under Section 58 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Act, 2015 (the "Act") and Rule 32 of the Anti-Dumping Duties Rules, 2022 (the "Rules") from M/s Pakistan Aluminium Beverage Cans Limited, Faisalabad (the "Applicant") for Review of the anti-dumping duties imposed on dumped imports of Aluminium Beverage Cans of capacities 250 ml to 300 ml ("Aluminium Beverage Cans") into Pakistan originating in and/or exported from Jordan, Sri Lanka and United Arab Emirates (the "Exporting Countries"). The Applicant is a domestic producer of Aluminium Beverage Cans. The application is filed in response to the Commission's notice of impending expiry of the anti-dumping duties imposed on Aluminium Beverage Cans from the Exporting Countries. The notice of impending expiry was published in the official Gazette and national press on November 13, 2024.

Product under Review:

The product for which this Review is initiated is Aluminium Beverage Cans of capacities 250 ml to 300 ml ("Aluminium Beverage Cans"), originating in and/or exported from the Exporting Countries to Pakistan (the "product under Review"). The said product is classified under Pakistan Customs Tariff Heading No.7612.9030. The product under review is used for packaging of beverages.

Period of Review ("POR"):

The Applicant has provided data/information for the period of three years i.e. from October 01, 2021 to September 30, 2024. However, the Commission decided the period of review ("POR") would be the last three years i.e. from January 01, 2022 to December 31, 2024.

Basis for Review:

The Applicant has claimed that there is a likelihood of continuation or recurrence of dumping of the product under review into Pakistan by the exporters/foreign producers from the Exporting Countries which may lead to continuation or recurrence of injury to the domestic industry. The Applicant has provided in the application information and evidence in accordance with provisions of the Act and Rules.

Initiation of Review:

Upon initial examination of the information and evidence provided in the application, the Commission is satisfied that the application *prima facie* justify for initiation of the Review under Section 58 of the Act. Therefore, the Commission has decided to initiate a review pursuant to Section 58 of the Act to determine whether the expiry of the anti-dumping duties imposed on dumped imports of Aluminium Beverage Cans from the Exporting Countries would likely lead to the continuation or recurrence of dumping of the product under review and injury to the domestic industry, or not.

Continuation of Anti-dumping Duty:

The anti-dumping duties on the dumped import of Aluminium Beverage Cans from the Exporting Countries is currently enforced till February 19, 2025. Further, in terms of Section 58(3) of the Act, the anti-dumping duties will remain enforced pending the outcome of the Review.

Hearing:
